- 2. If you would like to be a model for any treatment or if you bring a registered staff member or model for treatment as well then you must inform us on your registration page. Scheduling these procedures especially in a learning environment is critical. This can not be overemphasized. We want to insure that everyone receives the best education and exposure especially to the new protocols for Vectored lifting. Multiple procedures on models will only be allowed if time permits. This is usually not a problem but time is our main problem in insuring everyone receives the training.

Upon arriving for the course you will receive an organizing kit, a handpiece carrier, a mirror polishing kit, accessories for your laser, a thumb drive with information and videos of nearly all the procedure that we teach, and the Abbreviated laser Reference Manual which includes the new Vectored lift protocol. Leave a little room in your suitcase to get everything home.
- 4. Once you are registered and have secured a slot in the class, either I or Dr. Larry Lieberman will reach out to you to discuss your practice focus. We will also introduce you to PRF and its application in cosmetics. This is the highest end treatment that you can provide for your patient. This technology is a game changer for cosmetics.

Course Registration Information and Requirements

You must have attended a basic laser training module either in person or virtu-

ally sponsored by your Laser Manufacturer. This should include Laser Physics and Laser Safety. So many of the advanced applications depend on your knowing the tissue and laser physics and the tissue interaction. For consistency we will be covering some physics and safety, however what we cover is not a substitute for Phast or basic training.

- If you plan to perform Advanced Laser Applications then its highly recommended that you attended the Smoothlase/Nightlase training course either in person or virtually. Information about these courses can be obtained from your Laser Representative. We will also be covering these protocols as well in this class. How ever, the more you are exposed to these advanced procedures the more you will learn and be able to implement them with confidence in your practice after this course.
- 2. Model selection will be in this order. Attendee's will have first right to have procedures accomplished. This can be followed by the attending assistants. If you want to bring a model then they can also be treated by you or one of the other doctors if the model does not have a preference in this venue and if time permits. This is usually not a problem but its important to let you know that for a great learning experience you simply can not JAM additional people into the schedule. We will try our best but only after all other models and participants have been accepted for treatment and its determined that time is still available will any additional request be authorized. These advanced laser applications can not be rushed if you want outstanding results and they are often time consuming.
- 3. Breakfast and lunch for two days and dinner Friday Night will be provided. This Friday night dinner is always a surprise. Transportation and Accommodation Information


There are two airports of choice to get to Bradenton, Florida.


Tampa International- Airport Code is TPA. Tampa International is approximately one hour drive from the Advanced Laser Training Institute in Bradenton, Florida. See Map










If you reach 63rd St you've gone a little too far.

The second Airport you may want to check on is Sarasota-Bradenton International Airport. The Airport Code is SRQ. Delta Airlines has direct flights from Atlanta.



Start out going north on Airport Cir.

Take Airport Cir toward Rental Car.

If you reach Bradenton Connector you've gone about 0.2 miles too far.

Then 0.25 miles

Turn right onto Bradenton Connector.

If you reach Rental Car Row you've gone about 0.1 miles too for

Then 0.27 miles

Turn slight right onto Tamiami Trl/N Tamiami Trl/US-41 N/FL-45. Continue to follow FL-45.

FL-45 is 0.1 miles past Airport Auditorium Ln.

Then 5.39 miles

Turn left onto Cortez Rd/Tamiami Trl/US-41 S/FL-45/FL-684. Continue to follow Cortez Rd/FL-684. Sarasota Bradenton Airport is a very nice home town airport which is not like Atlanta or larger airports. Easy to get in and out. The airport is only about 20-25 minutes from the office. If you can book into Sarasota then you will eliminate the 1 hour drive from Tampa. However, the drive from Tampa takes you over some very scenic areas. The Gulf of Mexico, the Skyway Bridge are some of the most beautiful scenic views in all of Florida. The drive from Tampa is very nice.


